NATURE MAGIC ROUTE



Arrive at Rio Negro International Airport in **Medellin.** Enjoy bird-watching in the department of Antioquia. Take the morning tour around the Rio Blanco region, and travel back to Medellin in the afternoon.



Day 2

Fly to **Bahia Solano**, **25** minutes away. Travel to the Almejal beach where ships depart to spot whales and enjoy jungle trekking.



Sail towards the **Utria Inlet NNP** and tour around the mangroves as well as the park (sustainable-certified beaches).



Depart by boat towards Nuqui and fly back to Medellin. Fly from **Medellin-Bogota**, **35 minutes**. Visit Arvi Park during this tour. Enjoy a rich variety of gastronomic delights in



Day 5

Travel by car from Bogota to the **Chingaza** NNP, 1 hour and 30 minutes away, there you will be able to spot deer and even see spectacled bears living in a unique ecosystem called the Paramo (moor). Return to Bogota.

Fly from Bogota to the town of La Macarena, 50 minutes away. Travel to Caño Cristales, one of the most beautiful rivers in the world to see color-changing algae depending on the

Visit the Gold Museum, Monserrate Hill, and tour around La Candelaria historical downtown in **Bogota**. Visit the art exhibits throughout the city, including graffiti and fashion tours, as well as enjoy gastronomic experiences featuring major international and Colombian cuisine options.

Travel to the **Salt Cathedral in Zipaquira**, about 1 hour away by road. Visit a religious monument 590 feet underground, deep inside the heart of a mountain. Travel to Villa de Leyva in Boyaca by car, approximately 3 hours. One of Colombia's most beautiful heritage towns. A tour around the main square and stay at Colonial manors transformed into hotels.



Travel by car to **Cali**. **4 hours**. A salsa academy experience; take salsa lessons from the world champions of salsa. Visit the Cristo Rey Monument, San Antonio, the Paseo de los Gatos, and enjoy a gastronomic sample of the typical cuisine of





Fly to **Medellin**, **1 hour**. Learn about the city of innovation through its social transformation visiting the Metrocable, the España Library Park, Arvi Park, and Santa Elena to learn about the silleteros.

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Visit a typical Pueblito Paisa town, the Museum of Contemporary Art of Medellin, and the Via Primavera to meet the new fashion designers of **Medellin**.





Fly to **Cartagena de Indias**, **1 hour and 10 minutes away**.

Walk along the fascinating 8-mile wall that safeguards the city's historical downtown. Visit La Popa Hill, be part of the bicycle tour around Colonial streets and enjoy the Garcia Marquez gastronomic tour.





Visit the **Rosario Islands, 45 minutes** by boat from Cartagena de Indias. A heavenly 27-island archipelago, characterized by its crystal-clear waters and white sand.

Rionegro Airport in the city's outskirts and travel through the town of Santa Elena arriving at Arvi Park. Lodging accommodations are found within the Natural Park.



Fly to **Nuqui**. Surf for **35** minutes with the jungle as your backdrop. During the second half of the year, you will hear the song of the humpback whales. Trek through the jungle to spot poisonous frogs. Fly to Bogota connecting in Medellin.





Ride a Motorcycle from Bogota to the town of **Villa de Leyva** visiting traditional towns like Raquira and traveling through fascinating routes along La Candelaria Desert.



Ride motorcycle to the town of **El Cocuy** and hike to El Cocuy National Natural Park.



While hiking at **El Cocuy**, depart from base camp towards the top of the Pan de Azucar hill and back.







Depart from base camp back to the town of El Cocuy; and travel to Paipa to relax in the



Fly to Cali and then travel to Roldanillo for a day of paragliding where you'll find the strongest and steadiest winds in the world.



Enjoy horse riding and salsa music in **Cali.** Learn the art of riding a Colombian paso fino horse taking chalaneria and




Fly to **Guapi** and board a ship towards **Gorgona National Natural Park**, where the diving gear will be checked and ready for you to dive with whale sharks.

Days 1 and 2




